## **Notice of Race**

Yacht Club Port Bourgas (the Organising Authority) in co-operation with BULSTRAD VIENNA INSURANCE GROUP, the PORT of BOURGAS and the Municipality of Bourgas are pleased to invite the sailors to take part in

International Regatta Port Bourgas - Bulstrad Cup - 2019 to be held at Yacht Club Port Bourgas, Bourgas, Bulgaria and the southern Bulgarian Black Sea coast - west of the line between cape Emine and cape Maslen nos from 31<sup>st</sup> July - 04<sup>th</sup> of August 2019

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the Jury and may be less than disqualification.

[NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by boat.

[SP] denotes a rule which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing.

#### 1. Rules

- The regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 The following rules will also apply:
  - a) ORC Rating Systems Rules.
  - b) IRC Rules.
  - c) The class rules of National Class Monohull Conrad 25 R (C25R).
  - d) The International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS) will prevail over the RRS from sunset - 20:30 (local time) to sunrise - 06:00 (local time).
  - e) World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations (Inshore Races Category 4).
- The language of the regatta will be English. If there is a conflict between languages the 1.4 English text will take precedence.













#### 2. [DP][NP] Advertising and identification

Boats may be required to display bow numbers and/or advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

#### 3. Eligibility and entry

- The regatta is open to boats and to competitors who comply with WORLD SAILING Regulation 19 – Eligibility.
- Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form at the web page of Yacht Club Port 3.2 Bourgas – www.yachtclubportbourgas.org, and send it to the e-mail in SI 11, not later than 30<sup>th</sup> of July 2019.
- 3.3 In addition to the requirement of 3.2 each Owner or Skipper and shall deliver entry form, signed by all competitors on board of his boat and register at the Race Office no later than 10:30 on 01<sup>st</sup> August 2019.
- Crew lists may be amended until 10:30 on 01st August 2019 by filling a new form showing the 3.4 changes. After this time, changes in crew may be made only with the written permission of the Race Committee.
- 3.5 The Organising Authority is not responsible for any costs incurred by the non-acceptance of a boat's registration.
- 3.6 For visa purposes, if needed, it is essential to receive the following data: full name of the competitor (or coach, team leader, supporter, family, friend, etc.) (as per passport); passport number, date and place of issue, expiry date and a photocopy of passport showing identification photograph and the details listed above. Details regarding expected arrival date in Bulgaria and entry point must also be included.
- 3.7 Bulgarian Nationality competitors shall be in compliance with the BULSAF regulations (valid BULSAF card). This card must be submitted at Registration.
- 3.8 All personal data will be treated according to European and Bulgarian laws.

#### 4. Classification

No classification requirements will apply (see RRS 79)

#### 5. Fees

The entry fee for participation in the event will be BGN 10 for each crew member and shall be payable by bank transfer at registration to the following bank account:

#### 6. Regatta format

The regatta will consist of Single Series with 5 Inshore races, 1 Short Offshore Race and 1 Long Offshore Race for all classes.

#### 7. Schedule

#### **7.1** Schedule of races:

- 7.2 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 on the last day.
- No more than three races shall be sailed each day.

#### 8. [DP][NP] Measurement and equipment inspection

- A Technical Committee shall be appointed in accordance with RRS 92.
- Each boat shall produce a valid IRC or ORC Certificate for 2019. Each boat from National 8.2 Class Monohull Conrad 25 R (C25R) shall hold a valid control measurement certificate, endorsed for 2019. If the certificate is a photocopy, its authenticity shall be confirmed with an original stamp and signature from the issuing authority. If a boat is to produce measurement certificate for National Class Monohull Conrad 25 R (C25R), IRC or ORC Certificate in accordance with Racing Rule 78.2, she shall do so before 10:30 on 01st August
- Each boat shall be available for equipment inspection from 12:00 on 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2019 until 10:30 on 01<sup>st</sup> August 2019.
- 8.4 No changes shall be made on certificates after registration unless prescribed or approved by the Technical Committee and before the start of the first race.
- The time limit for a measurement protest by a boat on the ratings in the final entry list is two 8.5 hours after the posting of the final ratings. This changes RRS 62.2.













- In accordance with Racing Rule 78, competitors are responsible for maintaining their boat in 8.6 accordance with the Class Rules (for the purpose of Racing Rule 78, competitors are considered to be the owners).
- Measurement inspections at random during the regatta may be organised. 8.7
- **8.8** The fee for measurement protest will be BGN 200.

#### 9. Sailing instructions

Sailing instructions will be available during registration at the Race Office. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

#### 10. Classes

**10.1** The regatta will be sailed on the following classes:

"IRC" CLASS	IRC Certificate for 2019	there is no limit on the number of competitors, but they cannot be more than the number of crew members as per the Certificate of Registry
"ORC" CLASS	0	there is no limit on the number of competitors, but they cannot be more than the number of crew members as per the Certificate of Registry
CLASS "Conrad 25 R"		crew up to 7 competitors can be registered but no more than 5 of them can be on board racing in the separate races

- 10.2[NP] When at least 4 boats in a group are entered, the boats in classes "IRC" and "ORC" may be divided into two or more groups. The division into groups will be made by the Race Committee.
- 10.3[NP] At least 4 boats in National Class Monohull Conrad 25 R (C25R) shall be entered in order to form a separate group. Boats from National Class Monohull Conrad 25 R (C25R) are entitled to race at the same time also in classes "IRC" and "ORC".

11.2 The racing area will be in the southern Bulgarian Black Sea coast – west of the line between cape Emine and cape Maslen nos.

#### 12. The course

- **12.1** The course types will be:
  - Inshore Races Windward-Leeward courses 6 8 nm;
  - Short Offshore Race 27 nm;
  - Long Offshore Race 39 nm.
- Courses will be specified in the Sailing Instructions of the event. 12.2

#### **13. Protest Committee**

Protest Committee will be appointed in accordance with RRS 91(a).

#### 14. Scoring

- The low point system of RRS Appendix A shall apply. Points will be multiplied by the appropriate scoring coefficient.
- The scoring coefficient will be: 14.2
  - Inshore Races 1.0;
  - Short Offshore Race 1.5;
  - Long Offshore Race 2.0.
- The boats will be scored on their corrected times calculated by the "Time on Time" 14.3 scoring system.
- 14.4 At least 3 races are required to be completed to constitute the regatta series.
- Ties in the final ranking of the boats will be resolved in favour of the boat with better 14.5 score in the race with the highest coefficient, and if it does not resolve the tie, then in favour of the boat with better score in the other races with lower coefficient. This changes RRS A8.
- 14.6 Discards
  - When fewer than 3 Inshore races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores.
  - When 3 or more Inshore races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - The scores of the Short Offshore Race and the Long Offshore Race cannot be excluded.

#### 15. Berthing

The berth at Yacht Club Port Bourgas and berth 1 of the Port of Bourgas will be free of charge from 00:00 on 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2019 until 12:00 on 05<sup>th</sup> of August 2019.

#### 16. [DP][NP] Radio Communication

- All boats are required to have VHF radios with channels 16 and 69. 16.1
- 16.2 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats, except in an emergency or when using













equipment provided by the Race Committee. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

#### 17. [DP] Haul-out Restrictions

All boats shall be afloat from 10:30 on 01<sup>nd</sup> of August 2019. Hauling out after this time shall be done only after a written permission by the Race Committee.

#### 18. Diving Equipment and Plastic Pools

Without prior written permission of the Race Committee, underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around any participating boat between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

#### 19. Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to every boat placing first, second and third in each group and class. 19.1

#### 20. Disclaimer of liability and Risk Statement

- Competitors and support team participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk and they 20.1 are reminded of the provisions of RRS 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
  - 1. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
  - 2. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
  - 3. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
  - By participating in any race, they are satisfied that their boat is in good order, 4. equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
  - 5. The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, umpires and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
  - 6. The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- 20.2 The Organising Authority and all parties involved in the regatta organisation will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 21. [DP][NP] Media Rights, Cameras and Electronic Equipment

21.1 By participating in the regatta competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.













- Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as 21.2 specified by the Organizing Authority.
- 21.3 Selected competitors may be required to attend a press conference.

#### 22. Insurance

- 22.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- The Organizing Authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of 22.2 certificates.

#### By plane

Bourgas airport (BOJ) www.bourgas-airport.com is located 10 km north of the city. There are numerous flights from all over Europe flying to Bourgas, especially in summer.

- **International flights:** 
  - o Ryanair offers flights to Germany, Israel. Italy, Latvia, Poland, Slovakia;













- WizzAir offers flights to London Luton airport;
- S7 offers flights to Moscow.
- Seasonal flights: During the summer season, from May until September, charter companies offer flights from UK, Ireland, Czech Republic, Germany, Switzerland, Sweden, Norway, Poland, Hungary, etc. to Bourgas. Check the Bourgas airport website to receive actual information on departing/arriving airlines operating this season.
- Internal flights: Bulgaria Air offers every day flights to/from Sofia.

Bus No. 15 connects the airport with the city. The ticket costs BGN 1,00 (circa € 0,50) and the trip lasts about 20 - 30 minutes. This bus starts at the train station every 30 minutes from 06:00 to 23:00.
